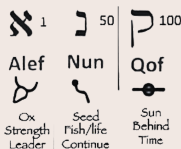

And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen. (Genesis 22:14)

This is the only place in the Bible where Jehovah Jireh is referenced. Abraham was so thankful when God provided a sacrifice that he called the name of it Jehovah Jireh.

Provisions. Have you needed any provisions in your life lately? Have you felt like God required more of you than you were willing to give? Well, just like Abraham, we can feel overwhelmed by the tasks God may be placing in front of us. But do not despair. God will provide the sacrifice needed if you are unable to fulfill it or if the sacrifice is more than you are able to give. He is our Jehovah Jireh. Many times he is testing our willingness, instead of our abilities. Be willing; he will provide.

And this man went up out of his city yearly to worship and to sacrifice unto the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. (1 Samuel 1:3)

Sabaoth used with Jehovah or Elohim is used at least 285 times in the Old Testament. It is most often used in Jeremiah, Numbers, and Isaiah.

The young Israel was used to wars and battles. Yet, they also knew the Lord of Hosts was often fighting for them. I always want God to fight for me.

Battles are going to come. They will seem like they never end. Samuel quickly identifies God as Jehovah Sabaoth in his writing. Samuel lived when God was the King of Israel, and he lived as Saul was king. He also anointed David to be king before Samuel died. God was always the Lord of Hosts in Samuel's mind.

We should also make God our Lord of Hosts in our spiritual battles with the enemy of our souls. God will fight for us if we put our trust in him.
