SCRIPTURE SPEAKING

SCRIPTURE SPEAKING

SCRIPTURE SPEAKING

Jesus is the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God. Because of who he was, he had the authority to speak to all the churches. He is the Alpha and Omega.

Jesus had clear messages to give to all the churches of Asia: Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamos, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia, and Laodicea.

A look at Jesus revealed a golden girdle, head and hair white like wool and snow, eyes like flames of fire, feet like fine brass, and a voice of many waters. His countenance was as the sun in its strength. His mouth had a two-edged sword. His hand had seven stars.

TAKEAWAYS

Revelation 3

- When Jesus says something, you can count on it. It is surety.
- Ephesus – left first love, needed to get it back quickly.
- Smyrna – needed to keep their faith, and they would get a crown of life.
- Pergamos – holding to the doctrine of Balaam, and warned to change quickly.
- Thyratira – hold fast until Jesus comes, overcome, and Jesus will give power.
- Sardis – not perfect before God, given instruction to strengthen the good things.
- Philadelphia – hold fast that no one take their crown.
- Laodicea – lukewarm, Jesus threatened to spew them out.
